HARTFORD POLICE INVESTIGATE TWO MONDAY EVENING SHOOTINGS

HARTFORD: On August 24, 2009 at approximately 10:10 p.m. Hartford Police responded to the area of Broad Street and Kenneth Street on numerous shots fired complaints. Officers located approximately twenty (20) 9mm spent shell casings and two (2) damaged vehicles in the area of 49 Kenneth Street. While on scene, officers learned that a seventeen year old bystander had been shot during the incident and had gone to Hartford Hospital for a single gunshot wound to her left ankle. Her injuries were non-life threatening and she was subsequently treated and released from the hospital. There is no suspect information at this time.

On August 24, 2009 at approximately 10:31 p.m., Hartford Police responded to 859 Albany Avenue, the "Stop n' Save" convenience store on a report of a person shot. Officers located a 26 year old Hartford resident suffering from gunshot wounds to his back and left shoulder. The victim who was unable to speak to officers due to his injuries was transported to St. Francis hospital where he is listed in critical but stable condition. Hartford Police Major Crimes Division as well as the Crime Scene Division responded to the scene. There is no suspect information at this time.

It is too early in the investigation to determine if the shootings are related. Anyone with information about either of these incidents is asked to contact Sergeant Rob Davis of the Hartford Police Department's Major Crimes Division at 860-757-4256.
