1. **Hartford's Annual Spring Cleanup**
"KAB GREAT AMERICAN CLEANUP"

In collaboration with [Knox Parks Foundation](#), DPW will provide service for the **spring cleanup** scheduled for four consecutive **Saturdays - April 18, April 25, May 2 and May 9, 2009.**

2. **Clean Sweep Avenue Program**

Starts **April, 2009** and ends **October, 2009.** Avenues sweep three times and litter vacuum two times per week with first & third shift DPW staff. The primary goal of "Clean Sweep Avenue," Hartford's arterial cleaning enhancement program, is to reduce litter in our major thoroughfares and our central business district as well as improve the attractiveness of Hartford.

3. **Street Sweeping**
(Follows the Waste & Recycling Trucks)

Starts **mid April, 2009** and ends **mid October, 2009.**

4. **Spring Leaf Collection**

Curbside collection for paper leaf bags only, service starts **Monday, April 13, 2009** and ends **Friday, May 1, 2009.** **Drop-off** bagged or loose leaves during the month of **April and May**; 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Monday through Friday; at the **Public Works Yard; 40 Jennings Road.**

**5. Hartford Gold
Leaf Composted Give Back Program**

Finished composting material “Hartford Gold” will be made available to residents starts end of **April, 2009 until all 800 to 1,000 cubic yards are hauled away.**

6. Household Hazardous Waste Collection

In Hartford - Saturday, **June 13, 2009** at Lewis Fox Middle School (corner of Albany Avenue and Blue Hills Avenue); and Saturday, **October 24, 2009** at Hartford WPCF (240 Brainard Road) from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

7. Electronic Recycling (E-Waste) Collection

New E-Waste law goes into effect on July 1, 2009. This law will make it easy for our residents to recycle their e-waste items. Drop-off and curbside will be available to resident. In addition, CRRA’s One Day Collection program will also be available along with drop-off at area businesses such as Best Buy, etc.

8. Hartford Recycles

Single-Stream Recycling

Pilot using 65 gallon recycling carts continues until expansion program starts for all residential units (by September 2009). End of pilot reporting will be available by mid summer 2009.

Normal Curbside Recycling Program

will continue with the 14-gallon recycling bins and 95-gallon recycling carts. These recyclables will be collected as non-pilot single-stream recyclables.

Expansion Proposal for Single-Stream Recycling with RecycleBank is currently going through the planning process.
