### Top 10 Lessons To Keep Hartford Clean:

- 1. Trash out too soon or too late.** Place trash carts on the curb by 7am the day of trash collection or after 4 pm the day before.
- 2. Over-stuffed trash carts or trash outside of the cart.** All trash must be put into plastic bags, tied and placed inside the city-issued trash cart. Lids should be closed.
- 3. Cardboard boxes.** Residents can not use cardboard boxes as trash carts. Cardboard must be flattened and placed in recycling container.
- 4. NOT recycling.** Recycling is the Law!
- 5. Bulky items on the curb.** Call 311 prior to placing at curbside.
- 6. Illegal dumping.** Do not dump household contents on public or private property.
- 7. Unacceptable waste.** Car parts, construction, household hazardous waste not collected at curbside. Call 311 for service information.
- 8. Tree limbs must be cut to three foot lengths, bundled and tied.**
- 9. Not using city-issued trash carts.** Residents in 1-6 family properties must use the city trash carts for city automated collection.
- 10. Not removing trash carts/recycle bins from the curb at the end of your trash collection day.** Residents must pull their trash carts/recycle bins into their yards same day of collection service.
