## **ATTENTION HARTFORD RESIDENTS!**

### **NEW ITEMS ADDED TO OUR RECYCLING PROGRAM**

Hartford residents can now recycle their **cereal boxes, shoe boxes and pasta boxes; aerosol cans and number 10 tin cans; and plastic, steel and aluminum recyclable containers up to 3 gallons in size.** Effective immediately, please separate these items from your trash, place in your recycling containers and set them out, along with the other recyclable items (please see below) for collection on your assigned waste collection day.

Please place the following items in your recycling bins:

**WHAT:** Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, bills, receipts, computer paper, mixed office paper, **cereal boxes, shoe boxes, pasta boxes** (please remove lining from cereal boxes and windows from pasta boxes), shred bills and receipts to destroy personal information and place all together in brown paper bags, **corrugated cardboard** (must be uncoated, flattened and tied with cotton or jute twine), **glass food & drink containers, aluminum, steel containers** to include **aerosol cans and #10 tin cans, juice boxes, milk/drink cartons, plastic food and laundry containers (PETE #1 & HDPE #2 symbol on containers).** Please empty and clean all containers but do not crush; sizes **up to 3 gallons.**

**WHEN:** Immediately

**WHERE:** Place in blue recycling containers

**WHO:** Residents, businesses and non-profit organizations

**WHY:** In Hartford, placing the above items in the recycling containers instead of the trash containers will help us to (1) keep our environment clean, (2) achieve the recycling goals and (3) reduce our city's trash disposal cost.
