All swimmers must obey rules. Wear your own swimming suit. Bring your own towel. Bathing caps not required. Swimming lessons certification available from beginner - swimmer, basic rescue & other specialized programs. In the afternoon & evenings, there are adult swims, family swims, water walking/aerobics & open swim. Schedules & programs vary depending on participant's interest & attendance. Weekends are open for recreational swim.
