Hartford Police Department Shooting Task Force 2012 Annual Report


- In June 2011 shootings in the City of Hartford were up 13.9% and climbing at a rate to exceed 180 to 200 victims for the year. After the inception of the Shooting Task Force shooting victims decreased rapidly and the year ended with 39 fewer shooting victims than the previous calendar year or a 21.8% decrease in persons struck by gunfire. See Attachment A for a monthly breakdown of shooting victims.
- Shooting victims through June 30th, 2012 are down 27.3% compared to June of the previous year.
- 51 fewer victims have been struck by gunfire in the one year time period since the inception of the Shooting Task Force in comparison to the same time period for the previous year. See Attachment B for a five year look at the July through June time frame.
- 11 fewer homicides have occurred in the one year time period since the inception of the Shooting Task Force in comparison to the same time period for the previous year. See Attachment C for a five year look at the July through June time frame.
- Over 214 Felony arrests have been made.
- Over 50 Misdemeanor arrests have been made.
- 76 firearms have been seized.
- Large quantities of Marijuana, Cocaine and Heroin have been seized.
- Thousands of dollars in U.S. currency have been seized.

- Over 80 Arrest Warrants have been issued by the court.
- Over 50 Search and Seizure Warrants have been served.
- Over 125 cases are currently assigned and actively under investigation.
- The gun related homicide clearance rate for the time frame of the Shooting Task Force currently stands at 10 out of 15 or 67%.
- 74 Criminal cases investigated by the Shooting Task Force are pending.
- 67 criminal cases have resulted in convictions.
- Sentences range from 3 years to 60 years to serve in prison with probation after sentence is completed. Most recently a sentence of 60 years, forty to serve and twenty years of probation was issued by the court for the shooting and robbery of a delivery driver.
- 366 Years of time to serve in prison for convictions have been ordered by the court.
- 209 Years of Probation have been ordered by the court.
- 8 educational and rehabilitative programs have been ordered by the court.
- Restitution has been ordered by the court in several cases.
- 12 criminal shooting cases are scheduled for trial.
- The Chiefs State's Attorney's Office, Hartford State's Attorney's Office, Connecticut State Police, State of Connecticut Probation, State of Connecticut Parole, State of Connecticut Department of


Correction, Drug Enforcement Administration, Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Manchester, East Hartford, West Hartford and Wethersfield Police Departments have all contributed extensively to the efforts listed above.
