

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **Project Description**: Provide a narrative description of the proposed development and use(s), including the size and square footage of all structures. Do you intend to rehabilitate the structure or build new?
2. **Developer Entity**: Identify the name of the entity legally responsible for the development. List the principals of the organization and all individuals who will be involved in the purchase and/or redevelopment of the City-owned parcel. Provide a description of the development experience of each of the principals and the name, address and telephone number of a designated contact person. For registered corporations, please include a certificate of good standing from the applicable Secretary of State's office.

Consideration will be given to Hartford based and/or minority or woman-owned businesses.

3. **Plans**: For those proposals that include new construction or gut rehabilitation, include a **conceptual** site plan, floor plan, and street facing elevation(s). The site plan should include parking and loading areas, driveways, building location and landscaping. The site plan shall be provided at a scale of 1" = 20' and floor plans and elevations shall be provided at a scale of 1" = 8'.
4. **Purchase Price**: Please provide an explanation for how you arrived at your proposed purchase price. The Committee will evaluate any findings of appraisers or marketability studies made by competent independent persons provided by the bidders. See Descriptions and Specifications sheet for minimum purchase prices.
5. **Sources and Uses of Funds**: Provide a breakdown of development sources and uses (both hard and soft costs) for the proposed project. Identify the type and probable sources of construction and permanent financing. Soft commitments will be required from selected developer prior to submitting sale approval documents to the City Council. Example budget forms available upon request.
6. **Governmental Assistance**: Identify the type and approximate amount of any Federal, State or Local government assistance essential to the financial feasibility of the project. Identify what steps have been taken to secure such funds.
7. **Schedule**: Present a detailed timeline for all major activities, including dates for pulling permits, securing all financing, start and completion of construction.
8. **Declaration of Delinquencies**: Complete and include the attached "Declaration of Delinquencies" form.
9. **Community Involvement**: Discuss your firm's involvement with the City of Hartford and any community-based organizations therein, over the past three (3) years. Please include community letters of support if any.
10. **Other**: Include any other information necessary to fully explain or support the proposal.
