RESOLUTION Meeting of September 10, 2008

Whereas, The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has produced revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) and a revised Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for Hartford County that will become effective on September 26, 2008. In order to continue to participate in the National Flood Insurance Program, each municipality must formally adopt the revised FIRM and FIS prior to the effective date. Furthermore, the Greater Hartford Flood Commission's "Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of the Flood Plain District" must be amended to formally recognize the new FIRM and FIS and also must incorporate various revisions in order to meet or exceed current minimum Federal and State floodplain regulations, and

Whereas, A public hearing was conducted on September 10, 2008 regarding adoption of revised FEMA Flood Insurance Rate Maps and Flood Insurance Study dated September 26, 2008, and adoption of amended Rules and Regulations Governing the use of the Flood Plain District, with Effective date of September 26, 2008; now, therefore,

Be it Resolved that the Greater Hartford Flood Commission hereby formally adopts the revised Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM) and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for Hartford County with an effective date of September 26, 2008, specifically as they relate to the area of jurisdiction of the Greater Hartford Flood Commission, and hereby commits to exercise its floodplain management authority in conformance with this revised FIRM and FIS, and;

Be it Further Resolved that the Greater Hartford Flood Commission hereby formally adopts revised "Rules and Regulations Governing the Use of the Flood Plain District" with an effective date of September 26, 2008, which formally incorporates the revised FIRM and FIS dated September 26, 2008, as well as other Federal and State floodplain requirements; and further that the Greater Hartford Flood Commission will exercise its authority in a manner consistent with these revised Rules and Regulations.

Action:

The above resolution was approved unanimously by the Greater Hartford Flood Commission at its meeting of September 10, 2008.
