Communication from Mayor Segarra, with accompanying resolution de authorization to enter into a ten-year tax abatement with Dillion Place Associates Limited Partnership, owner of Dillion Place Apartments and to enter into an assistance agreement with the Connecticut Department of Economic & Community Development (DECD) through which the City will receive reimbursement, subject to availability of funding.
2. Communication from Mayor Segarra, with accompanying resolution de authorization to enter into a ten-year tax abatement with Case Enterprises, owner of Sigourney Mews Apartments and to enter into an assistance agreement with the Connecticut Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) through which the City will receive reimbursement, subject to availability of funding.
3. Communication from Mayor Segarra, with accompanying resolution de authorizing the issuance of note by the City of Hartford by and through the Hartford Redevelopment Agency, in support of a development project located at 390 Capitol Avenue, the former Hartford Office Supply Building.
4. Communication from Mayor Segarra with accompanying resolution de authorization to acquire a 592 square foot parcel of land on the east side of Lewis Street from Talcott II Gold, LLC, as part of the City's Tiger Intermodal Triangle Project.
5. Communication from Mayor Segarra, with accompanying resolution de approval and submission of List of Community Programs eligible for the 2015 Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act Tax Credit Program to the CT Department of Revenue Services (DRS).
6. Communication from Mayor Segarra, with accompanying resolution de adoption of the City of Hartford Five-Year Consolidated Plan and Year One Action Plan and Authorizing the Submittal of Both Plans to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
