Dear Clerk Bazzano:

Please post this letter on your website immediately as public notice, pursuant to Charter Chapter IV, Section 7(c)(2), that at the next meeting of the City Council, or any subsequent meeting to which action is postponed, the undersigned intends to propose an amendment to the "Ordinance Amending An Ordinance Establishing A Public Recreational Facilities Authority for the City of Hartford And Authorizing The Transfer Of Real Property To Said Authority," which is scheduled for a public hearing on Tuesday, February 16, 2016.

The pending ordinance, which was introduced on January 25, 2016, amends the provisions of Ordinance no. 01-15, codified at sections 37-1 et. Seq. of the Municipal Code of the City of Hartford. The proposed amendment to the pending ordinance will further amend Ordinance no. 01-15 by adding thereto as the penultimate paragraph of Code Section 37-14, Miscellaneous, the following paragraph:

Prior to execution of any Lease amendment, and prior to the transfer of any city funds authorized by this ordinance, any Project Lessee shall enter into a Labor Peace Agreement between the Lessee and any Union which seeks to represent employees at the Project. The Labor Peace Agreement shall contain a no strike clause in which the union pledges not to strike or engage in adverse economic action at the Project. The term "Project" shall mean any development on the Ballpark Properties, Parcel B, C&D, Parcel E, Parcel F or Parcel G identified in the resolutions adopted by the Court of Common Council on October 14, 2014 in which the City retains a proprietary interest.
