**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 26 OF THE HARTFORD MUNICIPAL CODE**

COURT OF COMMON COUNCIL,  
CITY OF HARTFORD

October 17, 2012

Be It Ordained by the Court of Common Council of the City of Hartford:

That Chapter 26, Article I, Section 26-7.2 and Section 26-9 of the Hartford Municipal Code be amended as follows:

**Section 26-7.2. – Playing field user fees**

[The user fee for the issuance of a permit to utilize a city playing field shall be determined by city council by resolution and shall be made available to the public by and within the departments of human services and public works.]

- (a) User fees to utilize a City playing field shall be established by resolution of the Court of Common Council upon the recommendation of the Director of Public Works and the Director of Families, Children, Youth and Recreation
- (b) The Hartford Public Schools shall pay fees for the use of City parks, fields, and Dillon Stadium, for both practice and games. Such fees shall be established from time to time by resolution of the Court of Common Council upon the recommendation of the Director of Public Works and the Director of Families, Children, Youth and Recreation.

**Sec. 26-9. - Dillon Stadium fee schedule.**

(a) The charges for the lease of Dillon Stadium shall be as follows:

- (1) Professional teams and organizations:
  - (a) Day use (without sound) .....\$1,500.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (b) Day use (with sound) .....\$1,800.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (c) Night use (without sound).... \$1,700.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (d) Night use (with sound) .....\$2,000.00 per four (4) hour event.
- (2) Semiprofessional teams and organizations:
  - (a) Day use (without sound) .....\$720.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (b) Day use (with sound) .....[\$830.00] \$850.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (c) Night use (without sound)....\$850.00 per four (4) hour event.
  - (d) Night use (with sound) .....[\$938.00] \$1,000.00 per four (4) hour event.
- (3) Amateur teams, [and] organizations, and Hartford Public Schools:
  - (a) Day use (without sound) .....[\$170.00] \$200.00 per 2 hours event plus \$85.00 per hour for additional usage. Normal charges for electricity and sound shall apply as stated in subsection 7.
  - (b) Night use without sound...\$400.00 per 2 hours event plus \$10.00 per hour for additional usage. Normal charges for electricity and sound shall apply as stated in subsection 7.

[Day use (with sound) .....\$280.00]

[Night use (with sound) .....\$380.00 ]

(4) For one-time civic, patriotic, religious and recreational public events, excluding any organized team sport activity, to which there is no admission fee, charges may be waived, wholly or in part, at the discretion of the Director of [Parks and Recreation] Public Works, or his representative.

(5) Hartford Youth Organizations with 85% Hartford Resident Participation:

(a) \$75.00 per hour for field usage.

(b) \$50.00 per event for sound provided the event does not last more than 3 hours.

(c) \$25.00 per event for electricity provided the event does not last more than 3 hours.

([5]6) Practice use: The use of Dillon Stadium for practice is prohibited.

[Days .....\$40.00]

[Nights .....95.00]

([6]7) Other functions, including, but not limited to, rock concerts, musical events and shows:

(a) To be negotiated and separately approved by resolution of the Council.

([7] 8) The computation of charges for electricity and sound shall be as follows:

(a) Electricity (per event) .....\$75.00

(b) Electricity (per hour) .....\$25.00

(c) Sound (per event) .....\$75.00

(9) The Director of Public Works may adopt, from time to time, such rules and regulations for field use, as provided for in this article, as he may deem in the best interests of the City.

(b) Any future adjustments of the fees in subsection (a) shall be made with the approval of the Council upon the recommendation of the Director of [Parks and Recreation] Public Works and the Director of Families, Children, Youth and Recreation.

This section shall be effective as of July 1, 2013.
