**AN ORDINANCE CREATING TWO NON-VOTING EX-OFFICIO POSITIONS ON THE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS OF THE HARTFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

Be it ordained by the Court of Common Council of the City of Hartford

That Chapter 2, Article V, Division 2B of the Hartford Municipal Code be amended as follows

Sec. 2-151 Statement of Policy

Section 2(f) of the City Charter allows the Council to create up to two (2) non-voting ex-officio positions on the Board of Education for the students of the Hartford public schools, to be appointed by the mayor for a one-year term.

Sec. 2-152 Appointment of Ex-Officio Board Members to the Hartford Board of Education

(a) Membership. The Hartford Board of Education shall include two (2) non-voting ex-officio positions for students of the Hartford public schools to be appointed by the Mayor.

(b) Term. The ex officio members shall serve for a one (1) year term.

Sec. 2-153 The Mayor may consider the following qualifications and experiences with regard to the appointment of students to the Board of Education: experience in student government in Hartford Public Schools; residency in Hartford; and being selected by their peers through a process consistent with Board of Education policy.

This ordinance shall take effect July 1, 2012.
