WHEREAS, The Hartford Police Department is the primary law enforcement agency with statutory powers to enforce criminal and motor vehicle law within the City; and


WHEREAS, It is important for the City of Hartford to provide safe roadways for Hartford's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, The Connecticut Department of Transportation has allocated \$145,800 of funding to finance the 2006-2007 Expanded Driving Under the Influence Enforcement Program Grant in the City of Hartford; and

WHEREAS, The objective of the Program is to reduce the number of impaired driving fatalities through increased high visibility DUI enforcement and to communicate to the public, through the media, the increased level of DUI enforcement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Hartford, is hereby authorized to accept the 2006-2007 Expanded DUI Enforcement Program Grant funding in the amount of \$145,800 from the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, In 1997, the Connecticut General Assembly passed Public Act 97-259, which established a grant program to address the school readiness and child day care needs of families of young children within the State's priority school districts; and


WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office for Young Children, in partnership with the Mayor and the Superintendent of Schools, and in collaboration with the Legislatively-mandated Hartford School Readiness Council, is the fiscal agent in Hartford for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, The Hartford Department of Health and Human Services was funded by the Hartford School Readiness Council in Fiscal Year 2007-2008 to operate Burns Early Learning Center and nineteen additional child care slots divided between Parkville and Waverly Early Learning Centers; and

WHEREAS, The Hartford School Readiness Council has published an RFP for renewed operational funding for Fiscal Year 2007-2008, due for submission by March 26, 2007; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Court of Common Council authorizes the Mayor to apply for and accept funds of up to \$312,975 from the State Department of Education to operate the Burns Early Learning Center and nineteen additional City slots during Fiscal Year 2007-2008.

WHEREAS, Reading is a fundamental factor in language development in children, leading to good solid skills, necessary for lifelong achievement; and


