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

This is to certify that at a meeting of the Court of Common Council, May 29, 2012, the following RESOLUTION was passed.

**WHEREAS**, The 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Festival del Coqui wishes to serve alcohol at their event Sunday June 3, 2012 from 2:00 pm to 8:00 pm at the Hartford's Bushnell Park Pavilion; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Court of Common Council grants permission to the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Festival del Coqui to serve alcohol at the aforementioned event under the condition that the proper permits, if required, are obtained from the Liquor Control Division of the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection.

This is to certify that at a meeting of the Court of Common Council, May 29, 2012, the following RESOLUTION was passed as amended.

**WHEREAS**, The City of Hartford (City) and the Hartford Public Schools (HPS) are self-insured for the purpose of providing health insurance to employees and retirees, and

**WHEREAS**, The City and HPS desire to contract with an outside entity for the purpose of administering medical claims, and

**WHEREAS**, A Request for Proposals (RFP) for such services was issued and a joint City and HPS Medical Insurance RFP Committee reviewed and analyzed all proposals, interviewed four finalists - Anthem, Aetna, Cigna, and United Healthcare – and chose Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Connecticut as the recommended Third Party Medical Insurance Administrator, and

**WHEREAS**, The term of such contract shall be three years, from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015, with an option for two one-year extensions, and

**WHEREAS**, Based upon the fees proposed by Anthem for all components of the contract, it is estimated that there will be approximately \$200,000 in cost savings during the 2012-2013 fiscal year, now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Connecticut to serve as Third Party Medical Insurance Administrator, and subject to the terms and conditions that the Mayor and Corporation Counsel deem appropriate and in the best interest of the City, set forth herein; and be it further


**RESOLVED**, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all manner of other documents and to take such other actions as he and the Corporation Counsel may deem

appropriate and in the best interests of the City in order to effectuate the above transaction, and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That no person or entity shall be entitled to rely on, or otherwise claim any benefit by reason of this resolution should the Mayor fail to execute the aforementioned agreement, or to take any of the aforesaid actions, and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That all approvals and authorizations provided hereby are contingent upon there being an agreement between Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Connecticut and the CT Children's Medical Center by June 30, 2012, approving of said hospital as an in-network hospital for City employees and their dependents and such approvals and authorizations are further contingent upon and only shall be effective on and by means of, the Mayor executing such agreement and taking such actions, all of which shall be, in form and substance, acceptable to the Mayor and Corporation Counsel.
