ORDINANCE EXEMPTING CERTAIN AMBULANCE-TYPE MOTOR VEHICLES
FROM PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

COURT OF COMMON COUNCIL
City of Hartford
November 12, 1986

Section 31-21

Be it Ordained by the Court of Common Council of the City of Hartford:

Commencing with the first assessment date following the adoption of this ordinance any ambulance-type vehicle which is used exclusively for the purpose of transporting any medically incapacitated individual, except any such vehicle used to transport any such individual for payment, shall be exempt from personal property taxation. No such vehicle shall be exempt from personal property taxation on any assessment date unless the owner thereof files with the Assessor a sworn statement attesting that said vehicle is used exclusively for the purpose of transporting a medically incapacitated individual or individuals and that such transportation is without payment. Such sworn statement shall be filed with the Assessor on or before the first day of November following the assessment date for which the exemption is claimed.

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.

Adopted by the Court of Common Council at a regular meeting held December 22, 1986 by roll-call vote 9 to 0, and approved by the Mayor, December 24, 1986.
