

VETERAN'S PREFERENCE

ELIGIBILITY: In any examination for initial employment, an honorably discharged veteran of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard or Air Force of the United States who has served in time of war shall have ten points added to his or her passing grade if the veteran is currently eligible for at least a ten percent disability compensation or pension through the Veteran's Administration or five points if not so eligible.

SERVICE IN TIME OF WAR: Section 27-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes defines "service in time of war" as service of 90 or more days unless separated from service earlier because of a service Connecticut disability rated by the Veteran's Administration during the following:

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| Korean Hostilities | June 27, 1950 to January 31, 1955 |
| Vietnam Era | December 22, 1961 to July 1, 1975 |
| Peace Keeping Mission in Lebanon | September 29, 1982 to March 30, 1984 |
| Invasion of Grenada | October 25, 1983 to December 15, 1983 |
| Operation Earnest Will (Persian Gulf) | February 1, 1987 to July 23, 1987 |
| Invasion of Panama | December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990 |
| Operation Desert Storm & Operation Desert Shield | August 2, 1990 to June 30, 1994 |

PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY: Proof of eligibility for veteran's preference shall be provided by veterans in the form of their DD-214, a certified copy, photostatic copy, or other satisfactory evidence of honorable service. Disability veterans additionally shall submit a letter from the Veteran's Administration or other proof of disability certified by the Veteran's Administration. Proof of eligibility must be submitted no later than the closing date of the position announcement.

If you wish to exercise Veteran's Preference and meet the above eligibility requirements, answer all parts listed below and submit it with your application. If a part does not apply to you, answer "NO".

- Have you ever served on active duty in time of war in the United States military service? (Exclude tours of active duty for training in Reserves or National Guard).
- Have you ever been discharged from the armed service under other than honorable conditions? (You may omit any such discharge changed to honorable or general by a Discharge Review Board or similar authority). If "Yes", give details in Item 6 below.
- Do you claim 5 points preference based on active duty in the armed forces in time of war?
- Do you claim 10 points preference? If "Yes", please bring a copy of your DD-214 and the proof requested above as supplied by the VA.
- List dates, branch, and serial number of all active service in time of war.
