MAYOR ORDERS CITY FLAG TO HALF STAFF TO HONOR SGT. EDWARD J. FRANK II

(August 15, 2011) --- Mayor Pedro E. Segarra today ordered that all Hartford City Flags be flown at half-staff in honor of Sgt. Edward J. Frank II, who was born in Hartford and killed in Nalgham, Afghanistan when his mounted patrol vehicle was struck by an IED.

“Our hearts are heavy and our sympathies go out to the Frank family. This tragedy is such a loss to his family, his extended military family, his community and his state. We honor our Hometown Hero by flying our city flag at half staff, which will remain lowered until his memorial or burial. We salute the brave men and women who serve our great nation both at home and overseas,” said Mayor Segarra.
