## HPD COLLABORATIVE INVESTIGATION NETS CASH, NARCOTICS

*Ten Individuals Arrested*

### --- NEWS AND COMMUNITY STATEMENT ---

(February 23, 2012) --- The Hartford Police Department today executed six simultaneous search and seizure warrants in the Upper Albany neighborhood, resulting in cash and drugs being seized and several arrests.

The Department's Vice and Narcotics and Community Response Divisions, in partnership with Emergency Response Teams from Hartford, West Hartford, and the Central and North Central Regional Teams executed the warrants at 6:30 a.m. on Thursday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>. Assistance was also provided by the Connecticut State Police, the Department of Correction, East Central Narcotics Task Force, the FBI, the DEA and the ATF. The warrants were the result of a lengthy investigation by Vice and Narcotics detectives.

The warrants were served at 28-30 Vine Street, Apt. C2; 42-44 Vine Street, Apts. A2, B1 and C2; 46-48 Vine Street, Apt. A2; and 56 Vine Street, Apt. B1. The ten individuals arrested were:

- Ebony Moore, 8/24/76: arrested on a narcotics arrest warrant;
- Morris Carter, Jr., 11/29/88: arrested for a narcotics arrest warrant;
- Joshua Easterling, 2/7/87: arrested for narcotics arrest warrant;
- Kyshifa Boyd, 4/5/90: arrested for a narcotics arrest warrant;
- Ebony Cobbs, 5/7/82: charged with possession of narcotics, possession with intent to sell, possession within 1500 feet of a school; and operating a drug factory;
- Geneva Cobbs, 2/18/88: charged with possession of narcotics, possession with intent to sell, possession within 1500 feet of a school; and operating a drug factory;
- Willie Foreman, 1/27/70: charged with possession of narcotics, possession with intent to sell, possession within 1500 feet of a school; and operating a drug factory;
- Harold Zene, 4/17/70: charged with possession of narcotics and criminal trespass;
- Paul Drawhorn, 8/27/72: charged with criminal trespass;
- Eric Gomes, 6/28/66: charged with possession of narcotic and criminal trespass.
