Winston had served as a substitute teacher with the Hartford Public Schools before becoming Assistant Town Clerk. He also worked for Aetna, Park City Hospital in Bridgeport, the University of Hartford and UConn Medical Center. He had a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from Central Connecticut State University and attended Capital Community College prior to obtaining his four-year degree.
