GROUDBREAKING EVENT IS A GREEN EVENT

(October 4, 2011) --- Hartford Mayor Pedro E. Segarra today praised Hartford Hospital for creating job opportunities and helping the City go green. A groundbreaking ceremony took place this morning for a new parking structure on Hudson Street that includes an area to charge electric cars.

“This project is good for the local economy because it will create 150 jobs. In addition, as part of our *One City, One Plan* for conservation and development, it is important that we work collaboratively with our corporate citizens. I applaud Hartford Hospital to taking this bold, green, and major step. Not only will the structure be made largely of recycled material, but green space will be restored to the area and it will be convenient to charge electric cars,” said Mayor Segarra.

The \$40 million project will also include an employee exercise facility to help promote a Healthy Hartford as well.
