HARTFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS WILL BE CLOSED AGAIN ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1

NEWS AND COMMUNITY RELEASE

(October 31, 2011)--- From Mayor Pedro E. Segarra:

“Public safety is paramount. Patience is important in these stressful times. As the City continues to recover from this historic storm by clearing debris, opening roads, and restoring power, we must ensure the safety of all of our residents, especially our children. Because so many families are still without power and several streets and sidewalks are not passable because of downed lines and branches, Supt. Dr. Christina Kishimoto has informed me that Hartford Public Schools will be closed again on Tuesday, November 1st. The Central Office will be open,” stated Mayor Pedro E. Segarra.

“The Superintendent also informs me that Hartford Public Schools are offering student lunches Tuesday at Bulkeley High School, Hartford Public High School, Weaver High School, America’s Choice at SAND and McDonough Expeditionary Learning School from 11:30 to 12:30 PM for any Hartford student,” added the Mayor.
