HARTFORD GETS SIGNIFICANT TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT INVESTMENT MONEY

(October 13, 2011)--- Today Mayor Pedro E. Segarra acknowledged the Governor and ConnDOT Commission Redeker for their commitment to a significant transit-oriented development (TOD) project in Downtown Hartford. The \$730,000 is designated to help with development efforts around Union Station in advance of the New Haven-Hartford-Springfield rail line and the planned New Britain-Hartford Busway.

“This is a tremendous investment in our *One City, One Plan* for conservation and development -- our strategic 10-year plan to better connect our neighborhoods and the city to the region and beyond. As Hartford continues to position itself as the regional leader in future economic development and growth, Connecticut’s Capital City will be the transportation center and job hub of the state.
