The City of Hartford Health and Human Services Department, in partnership with the Hartford Public Library and the Hartford Food System, will sponsor an evening of conversation with Mark Winne, author of "Food Rebels, Guerrilla Gardeners and Smart-Cookin' Mamas; Fighting back in an Age of Industrial Agriculture" on Thursday September 30, 2010 from 5:00 to 7:45 PM at the Hartford Public Library located at 500 Main Street in Downtown Hartford.

In this book, Mr. Winne shows how people are reclaiming their connection to their food and their health. He covers everything from urban farming in Cleveland to buffalo restoration on Native American reservations to food-education classes in diabetes-prone neighborhoods.
