## **SUNDAY AT 8:00PM: MAYOR SEGARRA DECLARES SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING BAN**

**(February 28, 2015)** Mayor Pedro E. Segarra has declared a snow emergency parking ban for the City of Hartford, beginning at 8:00pm on Sunday, March 1, 2015 and ending at 10:00am on Monday, March 2, 2015. As it is the weekend, all Hartford Public Schools will be closed and lots will be available for parking, however, cars must be moved by 10:00am on Monday. It is expected that schools will be closed on Monday.

“The forecast has been consistent in that most of the snow will fall after midnight on Sunday. Our snow clearing efforts have been ongoing and fortunately the weather is helping,” said Mayor Segarra. “However, cars need to be off the roads in order to make our Monday morning commute as easy as possible given the storm.”

During a snow emergency parking ban, all on-street parking is prohibited throughout the City of Hartford. Any vehicles not removed from City streets by the start of the parking ban will be ticketed and towed. Residents without access to off-street parking should move their vehicles to one of the following authorized parking areas before the start of the parking ban:

- Morgan Street Garage
- 2 Holcomb Street Lot

- Keney Park Entrance Lot—Ridgefield Street
- KDA Center Lot—Naugatuck Street
- Pope Park Center Lot—Park Terrace
- Metzner Center Lot—Franklin Avenue
- Colt Park Lot—Wawarme Avenue
- Elizabeth Park Lots
- All Hartford Schools Parking Lots

Residents should remove their vehicles from the lots promptly following the end of the parking ban. Residents whose vehicles are towed during the parking ban should contact the Hartford Police Department at (860) 757-4000. The cost for retrieving a towed vehicle is \$93.59. An additional \$99.00 ticket will be issued which owners are responsible for paying before the answer date.
