

# TRAFFIC ALERT



## October 8, 2016

More than 17,000 participants will be on the roads of Hartford, West Hartford, South Windsor and East Hartford for the 2016 Eversource Hartford Marathon and Half Marathon. On race day, road closures and travel delays will begin at 7:30 am and will exist throughout the city of Hartford and surrounding towns until 2:00 pm.

To assist with travel plans, race organizers along with local police departments and volunteers will be stationed along the course route to help with foot traffic and spectator questions.

### **Best access to St. Francis Hospital:**

#### **From North:**

**Albany Avenue to Woodland Street**

#### **From East, South and I-91**

**I-84 West to Asylum Street, Exit 48**

**Exit 48 is marked with permanent hospital route signs. Emergency vehicles follow the posted route which is Garden Street (n) to Collins Street (w)**

#### **From West:**

**I-84 East to Exit 49 Ann/High Street. Straight on S. Chapel. Left on Ann Uccello. Go over 84. Left on N. Chapel and access I-84 westbound. On I-84, keep to right and exit at 48.**

**Exit 48 is marked with permanent hospital route signs. Emergency vehicles follow the posted route which is Garden Street (n) to Collins Street (w) To Homestead Avenue to Woodland Street**

**No access from I-84 Sigourney Street of Sisson Avenue Exits between 7-11 am**
