More than 17,000 participants will be on the roads of Hartford, West Hartford, South Windsor and East Hartford for the 2016 Eversource Hartford Marathon and Half Marathon. On race day, road closures and travel delays will begin at 7:30 am and will exist throughout the city of Hartford and surrounding towns until 2:00 pm.

To assist with travel plans, race organizers along with local police departments and volunteers will be stationed along the course route to help with foot traffic and spectator questions.

Between the hours of 8:30 – 10:00 am access directly to campus will be delayed.

Best access to UConn Law School:

From North, East and South:

I-84 West to Asylum Street Exit, Asylum Avenue to Woodland Street to Farmington Avenue to Sherman Street

From West:

I-84 East to High Street, Ann Street or Main Street

To Asylum Street to Woodland Street to Farmington Avenue to Sherman Street

**No access from I-84 Sigourney Street or Sisson Avenue Exits
between 8 – 11 am**
