17,000 participants will be on the roads of Hartford as the 2015 Eversource Hartford Marathon runs through town. To assist with travel plans on race day, please see the road closure chart below.

Roads will reopen as runners pass. When possible, police will direct cross traffic during the race. Please expect delays and detours.
