# HARTFORD POLICE INVESTIGATE CHRISTMAS HOMICIDE

(Hartford) – Hartford Police Patrol officers responded to Paul’s Ranch House located at 3281 Main St. at 10:44 PM December 25, 2007 for a reported person shot within that establishment. Responding officers found a Black male suffering from a gunshot wound to the chest at that location. Two other victims with gunshot wounds were located a short time later, one while being involved in a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Main St. and Mather St. The third victim was located at the intersection of Garden St. and Capen St.

The victim located at Paul’s Ranch House, OShane Green, 18 years old from Bloomfield, was transported to St. Francis Hospital by Emergency Medical Personnel where he died of his wound at 02:21. The victim located in the motor vehicle accident, Leonard Green 27 years old from Hartford, was transported by EMS to Hartford Hospital where he is in serious condition. The victim found at Garden St. and Capen St., Wayne Bailey, 29 years old from Hartford, was transported to St. Francis Hospital by EMS where he was treated and released for gunshot wounds.

Hartford Police are seeking a Hispanic male, approximate age 35 years old, balding, 5 feet 6 inches, stocky build, scruffy chin strap beard, wearing a gray long sleeved shirt or sweat shirt who was customer in the Ranch House at the time of the homicide. This man was with another possible younger Hispanic male wearing a dark sweatshirt with a black hat.
