TWO CHARGED IN THE 2006 MURDER OF CITY TEEN

Hartford, Conn. – On September 2, 2009, Hartford Police arrested **Paul Davis (12/25/84)** of 140 Oakland Terrace and **AcKeem Riley (06/08/89)** of 358 Woodland Street in connection with the May 28, 2006 murder of 15 year old Kerry Foster, Jr. and shooting of 14 year old Cinque Sutherland.

On May 28, 2006 at approximately 11:24 p.m., Hartford Police received a report of gunshots in the area of 50-52 Clark Street. Responding officers located two teenagers lying on the sidewalk directly in front of 50-52 Clark Street suffering from numerous gunshot wounds. The victims were transported to local hospitals. Kerry Foster succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 11:53 p.m. Cinque Sutherland survived his injuries.

After a relentless investigation by the Hartford Police Department, the State of Connecticut Department of Correction and the Cold Case Unit in the Office of the Chief State's Attorney, detectives from the Hartford Police Department's Major Crimes Division obtained arrest warrants against Davis and Riley. Davis and Riley, who are currently in custody of the State of Connecticut Department of Correction on unrelated charges were formally arrested for this 2006 murder and charged with Capital Felony, Murder, Conspiracy to Commit Murder, Assault 1st Degree and Risk of Injury to a Minor. A \$1,000,000 bond was ordered for both parties.

In commenting about these arrests Chief Daryl K. Roberts stated: "These arrests were a direct result of the on-going cooperative effort between the Hartford Police Department, the States Attorney's Office Cold Case Unit and the Department of Correction to solve outstanding cases." Chief Roberts also re-enforced the Hartford Police Department's commitment to the families of the victims saying "We will never forget. The men and women of the Hartford Police Department will not stop until justice is served for these families."
